**ResMed specializes in cloud-connected medical equipment, including CPAP devices and masks for sleep apnea, ventilators for respiratory diseases, and software for out-of-hospital care agencies. They aim to improve transitions of care for seniors and their caregivers.**

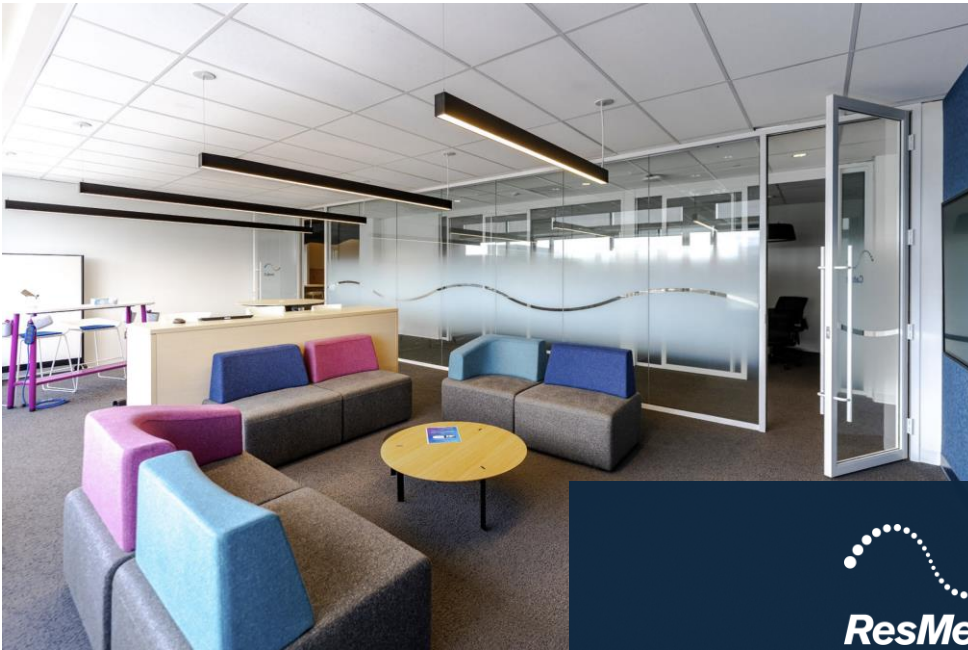
While ResMed is headquartered in San Diego, California, their presence is global, having had an office located in Halifax for several years. ResMed teamed up with Atlantic Business Interiors and SGH Design Partners to facilitate the transition to their new office in Bedford, Nova Scotia.

This transition involved a conceptual shift in workplace strategy to accommodate their mobile and hybrid employees.



# Their Challenge

**ResMed's objectives involved optimizing space utilization in their new office environment, transitioning to an unassigned workspace model.**



Relocating ResMed's Halifax office to Bedford, Nova Scotia, demanded a comprehensive redesign of their workspace, encompassing nearly 28,000 USF spread across a full floor.

The workstation furniture needed to support a 'plug and play' approach, offering flexibility and privacy for employees. Additionally, offices were to function as hotelling spaces while doubling as meeting rooms when not in use.

Meeting room tables were expected to accommodate advanced AV solutions and efficient cable management.

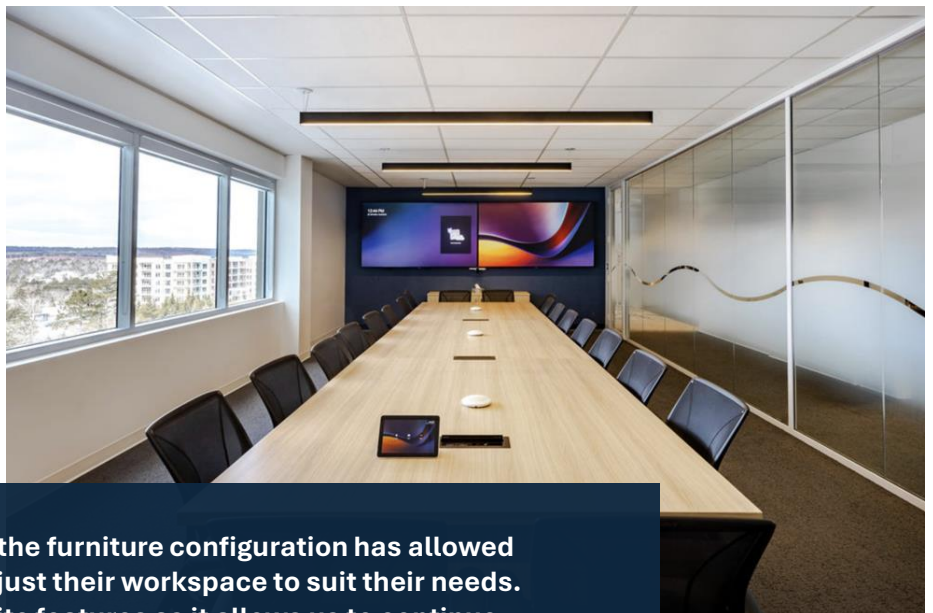
